Setsubun is usually observed the day before the first day of spring. It will be celebrated Feb 3rd this year. It is a cultural event to chase out evil spirits and usher in good health. One ritual is throwing beans as a symbolic gesture. This custom is supposed to have originated during the Muromachi period (1333-1573), and suggests that the beans represent the destruction of demon's eyes.



Many of the shrines hold Setsubun celebrations, each with their own traditions. Kinomiya Shrine is special by offering elaborate presents. Sumo wrestler, Atamifuji, is scheduled at the *mamemaki* (bean throwing ceremony) from 16:30. Izusan Shrine will start festivities at 16:00, while Imamiya Shrine begins at 17:00. Please note that the times shown are only approximate. Come join us in the celebration!
